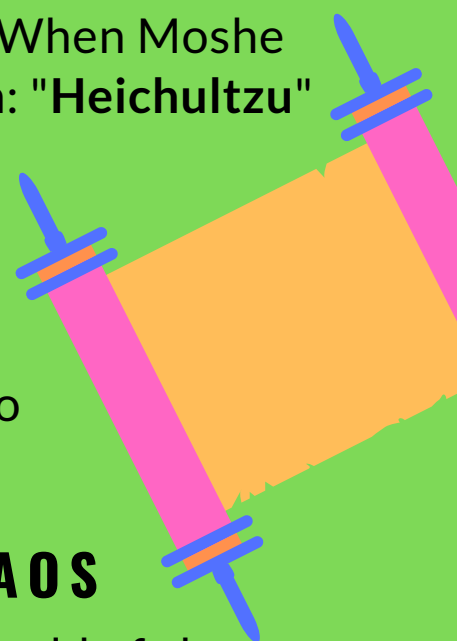

1 HEICHALTZU: ARM YOURSELF

When Midyan sent their women to lure Bnei Yisroel to sin, it caused a plague, resulting in 24,000 death tolls. Following the word of Hashem, Bnei Yisroel went to fight the Midyanites in a cry for revenge. When Moshe gave the instructions of war, he told them: "Heichultzu" "Arm yourselves" -Bamidbar 31:1-4



2 MIDYAN: STRIFE

The Midyanites represent the concept of baseless hatred, for they were people who instigated strife for no reason.

3 OLEM HATOHU: WORLD OF CHAOS

The Middos (Emotive Attributes) in the world of chaos were too intense and could not tolerate each other. Each light was so extreme, that it was unable to be contained in its vessel, thus shattering into chaos.



4 OLEM HATIKUN: WORLD OF ORDER

The Middos (Emotive Attributes) in the world of order, are combined, interrelated, and able to work with each other, thus creating order and unity.

5 YESHUS: EGO

Making oneself important and above all. When used negatively, it causes separateness and disunity.

6 BITTUL: HUMILITY

Making oneself humble, allows for interrelation with others and creates unity.



7 ELOKIM: DIFFRENTIATION

One of Hashem's names, Elokim, which constricts the G-dly energy in the world, represents limitations and differentiation.

8 HAVAYA: UNITY

One of Hashem's names, Havayah, which transcends the world, its limitations, and differentiation, represents unity.

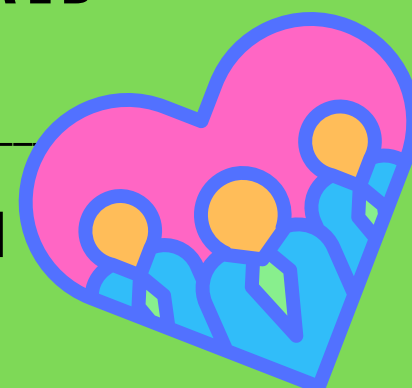
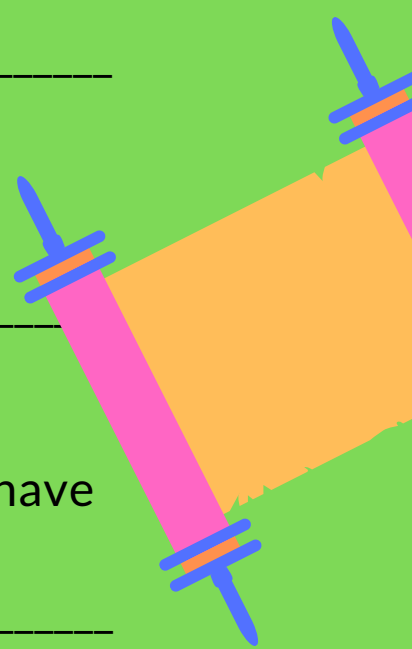
