Our bochurim bring a strong work ethic to the classroom and a determination to learn Torah and chassidus with sincerity and devotion. Our bochurim take an active role in their education, partnering with their parents and with us to create one cohesive team, dedicated to a rich and engaging mesivta experience.

JEWISH LEARNING

Our bochurim study a variety of subjects, including in-depth Gemara shiurim, day to day halacha l'maase, as well as yom tov halachos, and girsa. They also learn about the basic concepts of chassidus and the chassidic approaches to yomim tovim, as well as ma'amarim, Tanya, and sichos. Guided chavrusa learning and skill-based groups for some classes enable all bochurim to be appropriately challenged, while taking an active part in their learning and developing their knowledge at a pace that works for them. These courses are enhanced by dedicated faculty and full-time mashpi'im, under the direction of the hanhalah, Rabbi Eliezer Shusterman and Rabbi Mendel Unsdorfer.



GENERAL STUDIES

The goal of our high school program is to prepare students with the life and academic skill set they need for whatever their future may bring, whether that's a calling to Klei Kodesh, or a career in business, the professions, or trades. Our program is designed to meet the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania requirements for a high school diploma in terms of years and hours of study per subject.

Students should be prepared for the rigor of a dual curriculum program, and possess the maturity and mindset necessary to embrace that.

Erev Shabbos mitzvoyim, as well as farbrengens and trips to the Ohel help our bochorim continue to deepen both their hiskashrus to the Rebbe and their identities as chassidim.

Our students can also look forward to enjoying shabbatons and trips, twice-weekly gym sessions, and a variety of hands-on workshops like coding, jujitsu, and woodworking.

These programs ensure that the time our bochorim spend outside of the classroom is spiritually and physically nourishing, engaging, and enjoyable.

Our new boys school building in Greenfield is in the process of being completed for the upcoming school year. The second floor will serve as our dormitory, boasting 22 bedrooms, a brand new zal, a game room, and both indoor and outdoor lounge areas. The building also contains full kitchen facilities and a gym, both of which are newly renovated.

Two dorm counselors oversee our out of town students. Their goal is to create reasonable rules and guidelines that respect the needs,
