Jewish Learning

We believe that the focus of Judaic learning is inspiration, education, and observance. Our Judaic studies program is designed to strengthen students' foundations in core Jewish knowledge while nurturing the skills, curiosity, and desire to continue growing throughout their lives. Our curriculum includes , חומש, פרשת השבוע, הסטוריה נ"ך, ללקוטי שיחות, תניא, הלכה, taught with the goals of depth, relevance, and connection.

General Studies

Alongside Judaic studies, our General Studies program provides a strong academic foundation and meets all Pennsylvania State graduation requirements. Students study English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies, developing critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and academic confidence that prepare them for future success.

Together, our integrated program ensures that students graduate with both a deep connection to Torah and the academic tools needed for the next stage of their education. The school has an array of Chromebooks, Zoom Rooms, and SmartBoards to enable engaging and rigorous instruction. We assign students Yeshiva School email addresses, have filters and whitelists, and monitor student safety. In addition, we train teachers and students in the dos and don'ts of healthy digital citizenship.

Post-Graduation Pathways

At Yeshiva Girls School, we recognize that for most of our graduates, seminary is the next step after high school.

We are committed to ensuring that every girl who wishes to attend seminary is supported throughout the process. Our principals work closely with each student, providing personalized guidance, maintaining direct communication with seminaries, and offering financial aid information. Over the past four years, 99% of our graduates have been accepted to seminaries, including Machon Shoshanat Yerushalayim, Beis Chana Tzfas, Seminary Chaya Mushka, Oriya Institute, Tozhar Seminary, and others.

Our high school program is also designed to help students build academic momentum beyond seminary. Through dual-enrollment courses, and Advanced Placement options, students can earn college credits while in high school. When combined with seminary credits, this shortens the path to a bachelor’s degree. Those who do go on to college often attend Touro University. Our partnership with them allows for a seamless transfer of credits, easing the post-seminary academic journey.

Whether a student’s path includes seminary, college, or another meaningful pursuit, she graduates prepared, confident, and well-equipped for what comes next.



Hiskashrus & Extracurriculars

At Yeshiva Schools, we recognize that what happens outside of class is as essential as what happens in it.

Our extracurricular programming is designed to enrich the high school experience, strengthen hiskashrus, and give girls meaningful opportunities to connect, lead, and enjoy school life together. Our student leaders work closely with shlichos to plan engaging, well-run programs that are fun, purposeful, and rooted in chassidische values. Programming includes melaveh malkas, Rosh Chodesh brunches, farbrengens, Achos Tmimim programs, mother-daughter shabbatons, school plays, and more.

Chessed and community involvement are also central to student life. Girls are encouraged to participate in volunteer opportunities that allow them to give back and take responsibility for others, developing a strong sense of purpose and leadership through action.

A central hub of student life is Rivkah's Room, our daily davening space and student lounge, where many programs take place in a warm, relaxed, and welcoming atmosphere.

Dorm Life



Dorm life is a special and joyful part of the high school experience. Living together creates a lively, close-knit atmosphere where students form lasting friendships, enjoy shared experiences, and grow together beyond the classroom. Evenings, shabbosim, and downtime are filled with meaningful activities, bonding, and opportunities to relax and recharge in a supportive setting.

Students live in a newly renovated dorm designed to feel like a home. With small dorm groups, engaging extracurricular programming, and close guidance, girls enjoy a wholesome and enriching living experience. Beyond the dorm, Pittsburgh's welcoming Jewish community enhances student life through Shabbos meals, neighborhood shuls, and a sense of belonging that truly feels like an extended family.
